

How to get to Kingston University (Detailed directions for Kingston Hill campus follow)

Travel directions: by train

Trains run regularly from London Waterloo to **Kingston upon Thames** and **Surbiton** stations (at least every 15 minutes). The train journey takes approximately 25 minutes.

Travel directions: by bus

Kingston University free bus service

During term time, the University runs a free bus service between campuses.

Travel directions: by car

We recommend that you check up-to-date travel information for details of any road works affecting the area. You can find helpful links on our website.

From the North:

Take the M1 to junction 6a (M25), then the M25 to junction 13 (A30). Follow the signs to the A308 (Kingston) through Staines, Sunbury, Hampton Court and on to Kingston Bridge.

From central London:

Follow the A3 to the Robin Hood roundabout and then take the right lane filter onto Kingston Vale (A308).

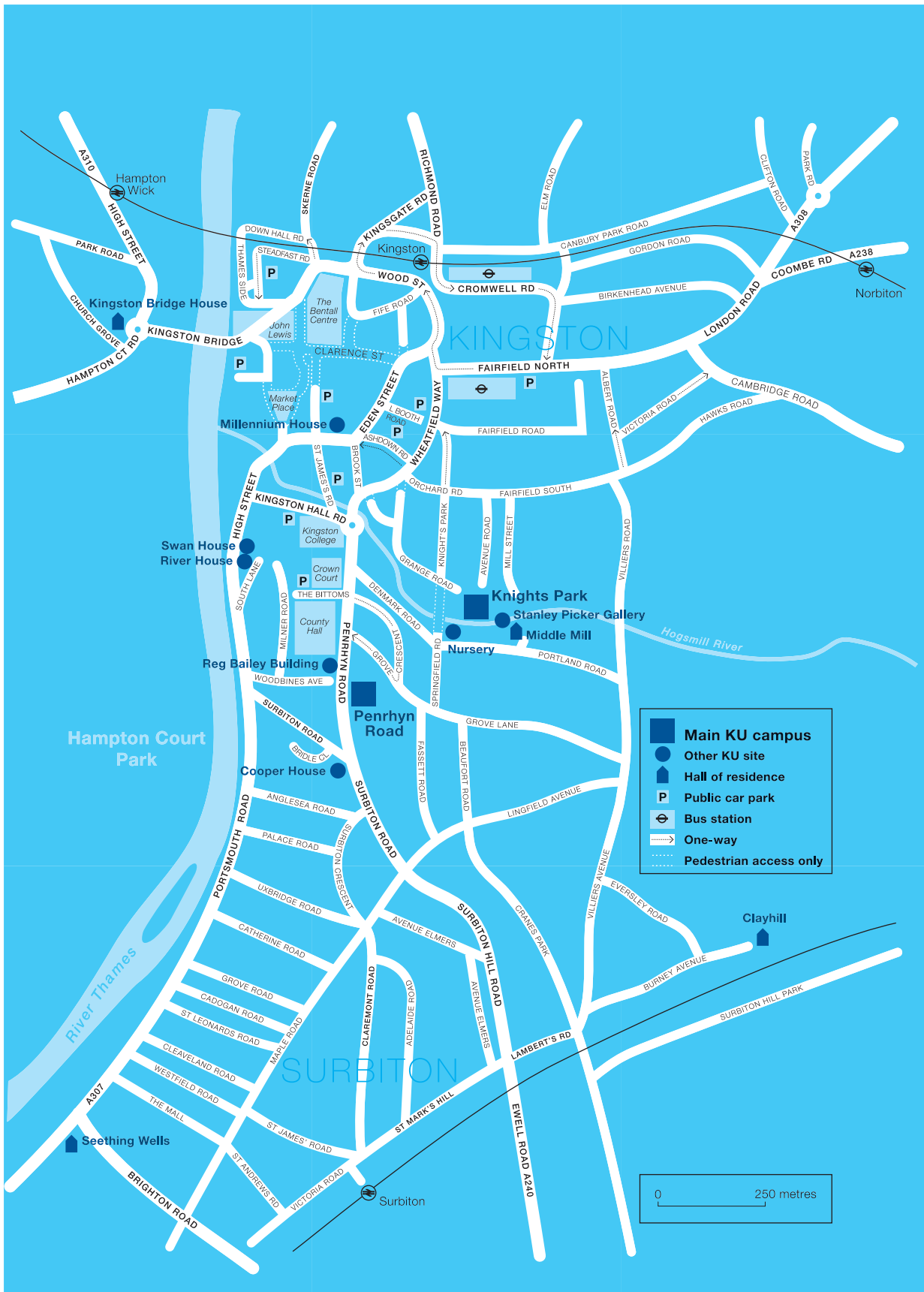
From the South:

Take the M25 to junction 9 and then the A243 to Surbiton. Follow the signs to Kingston.

From the South West:

Take the M3 to Sunbury and then the A308 to Hampton Court. Follow the signs to Kingston.

How to get to Kingston Hill

Kingston Hill, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey, KT2 7LB

Travel directions: by train and bus

- After taking the train from London Waterloo to Kingston, exit the railway station and cross the pedestrian crossing towards The Blue Hawaii restaurant.
- Walk up Cromwell Road to the bus station.
- Take the 85 or K3 bus. Ask for Kingston University, Kingston Hill campus.
- Get off at the stop after St Anne's Catholic Church.

Alternatively, take the Kingston University bus (term time only) to the Kingston Hill or Roehampton Vale campuses. It passes the Cromwell Road bus stop roughly every 20 minutes (look for stop A2). You may need to request the bus to stop. Tell the driver which campus you need.

Travel directions: by car

We recommend that you check up-to-date travel information for details of any road works affecting the area. You can find helpful links on our website.

From the North:

- Take the M1 to junction 6a (M25) and then the M25 to junction 13 (A30).
- Follow the A30 to the A308.
- Take the A308 to the Hampton Court roundabout and turn right (signposted 'Guilford, A3, A309').
- Follow the A309 until it merges with the A3 (signposted 'A3 London').
- Exit the A3 at the Robin Hood roundabout (signposted 'A308 Kingston').
- The Kingston Hill campus is less than a mile from this exit - on the left, just before brow of hill.

From the South:

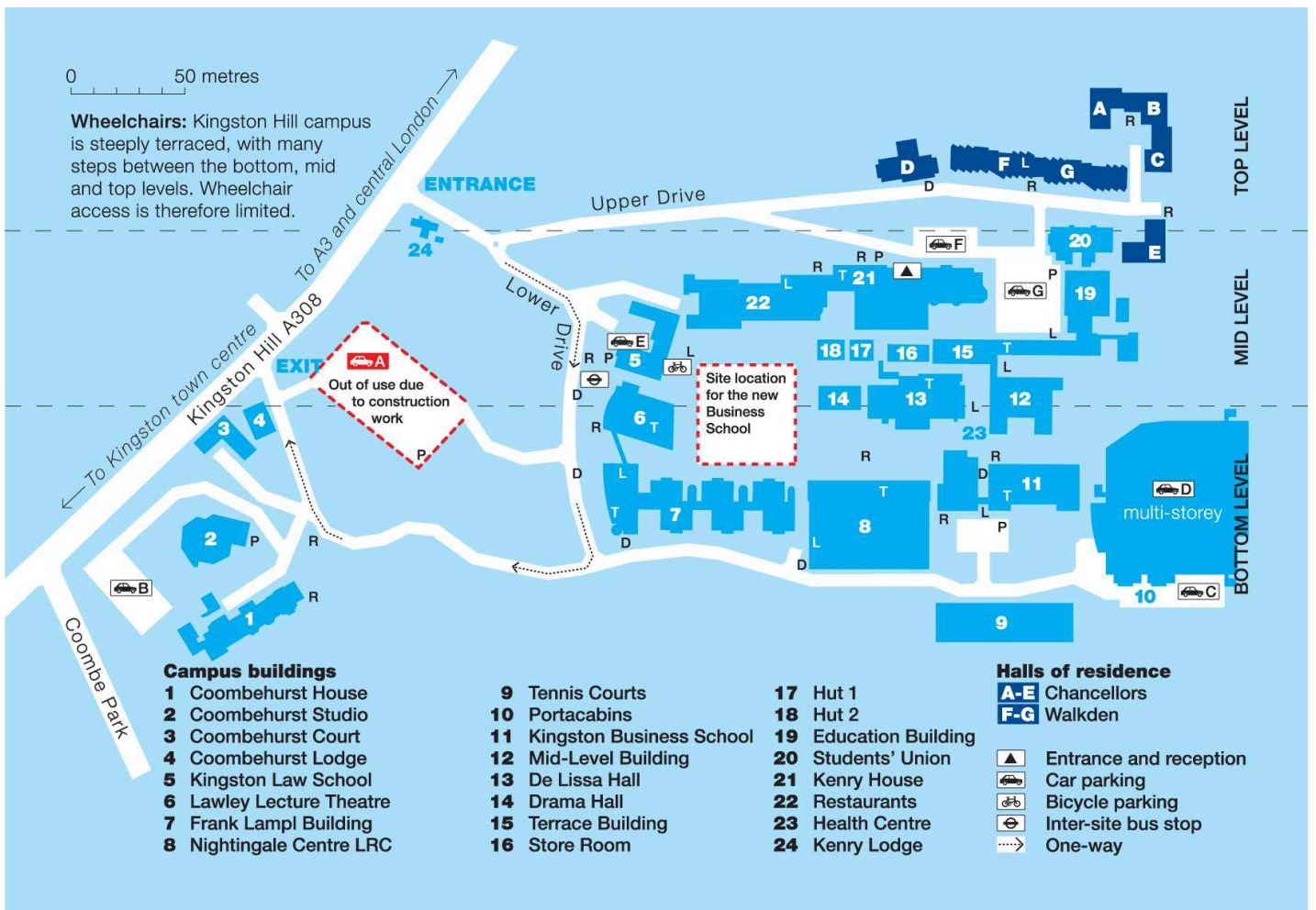
- Take the M25 to junction 9 (A243).
- Follow the A243 to the junction with the A3 at Hook roundabout.
- Take the A3 (signposted 'A3 London').
- Follow the directions from the A3 as above.

From London:

- Take the A3 from London and then follow the directions from that point as above.
