NOTES

1. It should be noted that the fees shown in this leaflet reflect the standard rates of tuition fees that may be applied to each course of study illustrated and are not intended to represent an exhaustive list of all the fees that may be applied.
2. Students undertaking partial repeats of a course, either full or part-time, will be charged according to the amount of work that they are required to repeat.
3. Some courses may require a non-refundable deposit to be paid in advance of enrolment.
4. Students being required to repeat a complete year of a part-time course of study will be charged the full years fees.
5. Additional charges, such as registration fees, accommodation and/or materials charges may be applicable on certain courses. Details of these are available from the relevant Faculty Student Office.
6. Residency status (e.g. Home or Overseas) once classified will normally be retained for the duration of the course.
