Gareth Parry is Professor of Education and Director of the Centre for the Study of Higher Education and Lifelong Learning at the University of Sheffield. He is a scholar of policy reform and system change in tertiary education in the UK and internationally. With Peter Scott and Claire Callender, he currently leads a BIS-funded research study on 'Understanding Higher Education in Further Education Institutions'.
